Dear Pastor, Church Family, and Co-laborer,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We hope this letter finds each of you enjoying His abundant blessings! We have been very busy in the work of the Lord since our last letter. I started off the month of May at Lumberton Correctional Institution. We had good attendance every night and had eight men call on the Lord for salvation. From there I traveled to Indiana for a tent revival and then to Arbroath, Scotland for the Highland Hills Mission week. The Lord allowed us to take a large group from different parts of the U.S. to learn more about missions and canvas the area with the Gospel. We were able to put over 8000 John and Romans in the homes of the people in Arbroath, as well as an invitation to the Bible study that is held there. On Wednesday of that week, we all went to the city center in Dundee where we took turns preaching the Gospel and distributing Gospel literature. What a blessing it was to see God stir hearts about the great need in Scotland and to tell others the good news of Jesus Christ.

June was very busy as well. I started off preaching a revival meeting at Blair's Fork B/C in Lenoir, NC. God moved in a supernatural way during this meeting, and we saw five people call on the Lord for salvation. I left there and traveled to Sampson Correctional Institution in Clinton, NC for another prison revival. The Lord gave us a good week at this facility. We were able to hold a bible study during the day and a regular service at night. Many men came out to the studies and to the revival services. There was a total of four men that called on the Lord for salvation during this time. We closed out the last two weeks of June in two different youth camps where we saw two more professions of faith. We also had one young man call on the Lord for salvation at our regular service at the Graham County Jail. We praise the Lord for saving sinners and touching lives!

Looking ahead, we have an extremely busy schedule for the rest of the year. In July, I will be traveling to England and Scotland to help a couple missionaries for several days. We also have a trip to Alaska planned for August to help another missionary family, as well as several prison meetings, revivals, Mission conferences, and another youth camp. Please pray for traveling grace and for souls to be saved for the glory of God. Also, help us pray for the funds for the trips to the U.K and to Alaska. We are still asking the Lord for some new monthly supporters to help with rising costs. Would you help us pray over this need? As you can imagine, traveling is increasingly expensive these days, but we know the Lord is able to provide.

Thank you for your continued support, both prayerfully and financially! We could not do what we do without you. If anyone would like for us to come by and give an update to your church or if we can be a help in anyway, please feel free to contact us. I have a few Sundays open this year and some next year. May the grace of our precious Lord be with you always!
