Twenty-four of them called on the Lord for salvation. The Gospel continues to be powerful even in this day and age!

As we move into November, we have several prison services planned. We would appreciate your continued prayers for the Lord to move in these facilities and bring about a change in many lives.

In May of next year, we are in the process of planning another group trip to Scotland for a week-long mission of literature distribution and evangelism. This would be an excellent opportunity for anyone interested in learning more about missions or seeking to become actively involved in world evangelism. We had a wonderful time last year, and we are filled with excitement about the potential impact of the Lord's work this time around.
