Your Missionaries to Scotland **Greetings Everyone!** 

We have much to share in this update, but we want to start by saying how grateful we are to all our supporting churches, both for praying for our family as well as your financial support. We cannot begin to express our gratitude for your partnership with us! It is hard to believe a year has passed since we began our deputation, and my, how the LORD has helped us! Even through blending our families, and ensuring we take time as needed for this, we are currently at 25% of our goal. We also anticipate our visas to cost between \$50,000 and \$60,000 for our family, but the Lord has already provided \$15,000 toward this. To God be the glory!

May was certainly a busy month for our family, as we traveled to parts of Georgia and North Carolina, as well as to Scotland for the Highland Hills Baptist Missions Meeting. We were grateful to help in the efforts to canvas the cities of Kirriemuir and Forfar through letterboxing, as well as the street ministry in Dundee. Sadie and I also celebrated our First Anniversary together! We want to extend a special thank you to the Alverson's and Van Voltenberg's for hosting the meeting and allowing us to have a small part in helping. Casen and Caraleena were able to see the field we have been called to, and Casen also took part in letterboxing and even decided to quote some scripture during street ministry. This is such an answer to prayer! We are also very grateful for the divine appointments that were had by several during the meeting!

Deputation slowed down a bit after returning to the states in June, as Sadie required surgery to repair a partially torn rotator cuff. She had been having trouble with her shoulder for some time, but after meeting with her doctor again, he recommended surgery. We found that he also had to and reattach her biceps tendon during the procedure. She has been recovering well and has begun her PT. We ask that you please pray for a quick and easy recovery. We are looking forward to the meetings we have scheduled over the next few months, for which she has been cleared to travel with a few precautions.

Please continue to keep our family in your prayers as we travel, and as always, pray for Caraleena's salvation. We also desire for more divine appointments, as we seek to honor the Lord and be a blessing to others!
