Greetings Friends and Faithful Supporters!

Thank you does not seem to truly express our gratitude to each of you for your faithful prayers and financial support for our family. We are eternally grateful to the Lord for each of you. We praise the Lord for his goodness, and are thrilled to share that **we have reached 35%** of our support! As we enter into a new year, we look to the Lord for his leadership and provision with great anticipation!

This past quarter has been filled with many miles and several opportunities to serve. October started out traveling from Family Camp with our home church to Indiana to be in multiple churches where we were able to help with visitation efforts and set up our first Bible tent. Our children sang songs, read scripture, passed out tracts and we preached the Gospel on the streets of Greenfield. We then traveled to Michigan for a mission conference where we were greatly encouraged, and then to Canada and New York to present and preach.

In November we traveled to Florida and preached chapel for a Christian School. The children were so eager to learn about missions in Scotland and had many great questions. After returning home, we were able to assist a local church with Thanksgiving baskets, and the Lord allowed us to provide 30 marked editions of the New Testament in them. We know that God's word will not return unto him void, and we trust the Lord will use these portions of scripture to bring someone to Salvation! We also traveled to North and South Carolina to present, and was able to preach in the Piedmont Preacher's Fellowship, meeting many new friends.

For the Christmas season we chose to take some time off to be with family, and be at our home church for the Who Will Go missions meeting. My, how the Lord helped us in these services. We did have some sickness with our children, but all are well now and we are thankful for that!

Looking ahead, we do have some prayer requests that we would ask you to help us with. Jacob and Chris are flying out for a mission trip to Honduras January 6th. Please pray for their safety and for divine appointments! We also desire that our calendar would be full this year, and that God would continue to financially provide for our visas, moving expenses and a vehicle to purchase once we arrive in country. It is our desire, if the Lord allows, to be in country by the Fall of 2027. Our visas will cost between \$50,000-\$60,000 (most of which is paying into their healthcare) and a good used 9-seater vehicle can be anywhere from \$15,000-\$25,000 USD. Moving costs (including airfare, a shipping container, furnishings for a house – as American furniture typically will not fit in their smaller doors, a rental vehicle until we can purchase one and move-in costs) we estimate will be roughly \$40,000-\$50,000. Much of these costs are subject to the exchange rate between the US Dollar and the British pound. In total, we estimate the cost to move will be at least \$135,000, but God is able! We have also had some car repairs needed that we trust the Lord will continue to provide for and to help keep us safe as we travel. Please help us pray that the Lord will meet these needs, but above all, please for Caraleena's salvation that she would be saved at a young age.

We greatly appreciate your partnership in prayer with us for these needs!
