Greetings Friends and Faithful Supporters!

Spring is upon us, and the cold of winter begins to fade. As life begins to spring forth out of the dark of winter, so it is with the soul that is set free from the chains of sin! What a beautiful picture of the change that takes place in a believer's life! Bless the Lord for the glorious gospel of Jesus Christ! I thank the Lord that we get to be a small part of his work! Thank you to each of you that have prayed for our family and have been so faithful to give. We are honored to partner with God's people to reach others with the Gospel!

We have faced many challenges over the last three months, but God has been faithful in all things. In January, our van broke down as we were en route to Florida for a meeting. But in God's providence, he allowed us to break down only a few minutes from a prophet's chamber that our family was able to use for the night. With the help of God's people, we were able to get our van into a shop for repairs and borrow a church van from one of our supporting churches to get us to our next meeting.

Sadie's dad took a fall in late February, and although it could have been worse, he did require a complete shoulder replacement. With his health situation, we took turns with her family to look after him, and continue to help as needed. My dad also had total knee replacement in January, for which Joshua was able to stay with him for a few days to help get him settled. Navigating deputation while caring for a loved one has its challenges, but we are thankful that we have been able to spend the extra time with family.

With March came warmer weather, and another challenge faced – the air stopped working in the van. We thought it just needed charged, but quickly found that there was a leak, requiring professional diagnostic. Thanks to the generosity of God's people, we were able to get our van in to be checked, but the part would take a couple of weeks to arrive. We now have the part in hand, and scheduled to have the repairs completed.

Although we have faced many challenges, God has allowed us to be in 22 new churches spanning many miles across Tennessee, Georgia, Florida, Kentucky, the Carolinas and Alabama. We have received several new commitments to partner with us, and we rejoice that God continues to meet our needs! To date, God has brought in \$31,000 toward our visas! To God be the glory!

Please continue to pray that the Lord will provide the remainder of the money needed for our visas, but the greatest desire is Caraleena's salvation, once she begins to understand her need. She is only five, but has started asking a few questions on occasion, and we rejoice that the Lord seems to be working. Also, help us pray that our parents continue to heal and strengthen, and that the Lord would grant them good health. Our calendar continues to fill up, and we desire to get to the field as soon as the Lord would allow it. Please help us pray our support will continue to increase quickly. Time is short, and the return of our Lord is at hand. Whether we make it to the field or are still on deputation, we desire to be found working in his fields when he comes!
