2026 Ministry Update

Greetings to you all in the Lord Jesus Christ! We have had the privilege of sharing our burden and calling for Honduras in seven different states during the months of March and April. We have traveled from south Mississippi to southwest Pennsylvania over these past two months. We have been encouraged and helped in every service we have attended, and our prayer is that we have also been an encouragement and help to each and every church we have visited. While on deputation, we are trying to raise support to get to Honduras, but it is also our priority to minister, encourage, and help in any way we can.

I am thankful for the opportunities the Lord has given us to serve and help others during deputation. We pray you all had a wonderful day in the Lord as you celebrated the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. We did not have any meetings scheduled the week of Resurrection Sunday, which allowed me to go with missionary Bro. Matt Pawley with "In the Trenches Ministry" to help move some items for a missionary. I met up with Bro. Pawley in Alabama, on April 1st we left for Wyoming and arrived back home on the 7th covering over 3,700 miles. We thank the Lord for safety in traveling there and back while pulling a 33-foot enclosed trailer.

After returning from the trip out west, we drove to Pennsylvania for the weekend. After returning home, we ended up making a late-night trip to the emergency room at children's hospital. Tucker was playing outside on a trampoline and landed on his arm behind his back, causing a break right above his left elbow that almost resulted in an open fracture. Thank the Lord, he is doing well and has been a champ through it all. He currently has three pins in his arm that will need to be removed mid-May.

Please keep us in your prayers as we will be heading out west for two and a half months. We have many miles ahead of us this summer. We leave the first week of May and will be in Oklahoma, Utah, Colorado, Idaho, Washington, Oregon, California, New Mexico, and Arizona, returning at the end of July for a very busy month back in the South in August. We are thankful for how the Lord has filled our calendar with opportunities to share our calling and burden for Honduras. We are still working to schedule meetings for the end of the year and are praying that the Lord will allow us to have all of our support raised by then so we can get to the field and serve where He has called us.

I thank the Lord for the many opportunities He has given me to open the Word of God and teach in many churches and youth programs this year. I would also like to praise the Lord for all the provisions He has made for us recently. He has been so faithful to our family!

I would like to ask you all to please help us pray about a few things:

- Safety as we travel many miles this Summer
- For us to be able to get in with an orthopedic doctor out west to remove Tucker's cast and pins along with complete healing for his elbow
- For us to meet the remainder of our support goal by the end of 2026
- That God would provide a rental house and meet the cost of relocating and purchasing what we need to live in Honduras
- For the funds to purchase the land behind the Children's Home to build on and expand the ministry
- And most of all, that the Lord would continue to work in the ministry in Santa Barbara, that we would see more souls saved, and that Christians would fully surrender to God and grow in the Lord

Even though we have thoroughly enjoyed the ministry of deputation, our hearts long to be in Honduras serving, proclaiming the Gospel, and discipling others. The Lord has truly blessed us with so much more than we could ever ask for. Thank you all so much for your continual prayers and financial support. We could not do what the Lord has called us to do without your faithfulness in prayer and obedience in giving.
