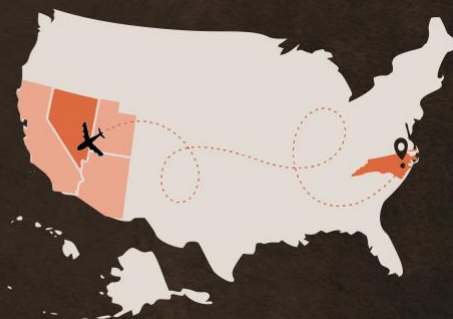

CHURCH PLANTING MISSIONARIES TO NEVADA & SOUTHWEST USA

Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

The last two months have flown by and have kept our family very busy. At the beginning of May, we had the opportunity to preach a Mother's Day service at one of our supporting churches close to home. It was a wonderful time to spend with many of the mothers, friends, and family members who mean so much to us before beginning another stretch of deputation.

After Mother's Day, we headed west toward Utah, stopping in Texas to preach a Wednesday evening service along the way. Once in Utah, we were blessed to spend time with the Howard family in St. George, who have been a tremendous encouragement to our family. We had the opportunity to preach and present our burden for Clark County, Nevada, at Brother Rickey Howard's church, Solid Rock Baptist Church. It was a blessing to reconnect with familiar faces from our first visit three years ago while also meeting many new people. We were also able to attend the Western Church Planters' Conference in Logan and presented our ministry in several churches throughout the state.

We took the opportunity to spend as much time as possible in Nevada while we were nearby and were able to attend our first church service in Las Vegas as well as able to meet with several pastors in the area. Much of our time in Nevada was spent in Mesquite becoming more familiar with the community and surveying potential places to live and establish a church. We were able to distribute tracts, meet local residents, and continue learning about the tremendous spiritual need in the area.

One thing that especially stood out to us was the growing influence of the LDS community. We learned that a second LDS temple is currently being built in Las Vegas and that more than ten LDS wards call Mesquite home. At the same time, while ministering in Utah, we heard the testimonies of two men who had been gloriously saved out of Mormonism. Their stories were a wonderful reminder that the Gospel is still the power of God unto salvation and that there is great hope for those who have been led into religious error.

As we left Utah and Nevada, we began June by attending the Southwestern Church Planters' Conference in Arizona. It was exciting to witness over \$100,000 given toward church planting efforts in six different states. All of these meetings and conferences were such an encouragement to us to remind us exactly what God is able to do in the western part of our country! After spending a week with several wonderful churches, we began making our way back east.

Since then, we have travelled through Tennessee, Kentucky, South Carolina, and North Carolina, logging more than 10,000 miles since Mother's Day. Along the way, we have preached, presented our ministry at several preachers' fellowships, and had the opportunity to assist with a nursing home service with a church in Kentucky.

Throughout these travels, we have been continually overwhelmed by the kindness, generosity, and encouragement of God's people. Everywhere we go, the Lord reminds us that He is faithfully using His churches to accomplish His work. We are thankful that He has watched over our family, providing safety throughout our travels and allowing us to complete another season of deputation without any vehicle problems. The Lord continues to provide, and we are currently at approximately 30% of our needed support with a busy schedule in the months ahead.

Thank you for your faithful prayers, encouragement, and financial support. Every mile travelled and every church visited brings us one step closer to planting a Bible-believing church in Clark County, Nevada. We are grateful to have you serving alongside our family as we seek to reach the Southwest with the Gospel. Please continue to pray for our family for safe travels, meetings, and financial support to help get us to the field the Lord has called us to quickly. Also pray we are able to see souls saved, laborers called, and God's will done in the lives of people we meet along the way!
