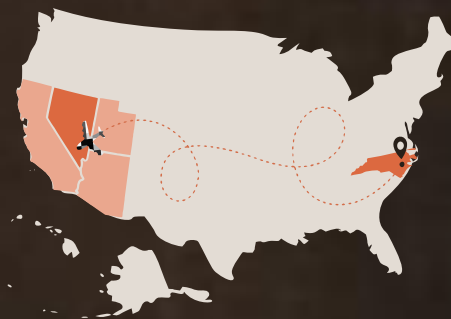

We made it safely home at the beginning of July after our two-month trip through the western part of the country and have remained a little closer to home since. We have traveled from the coast to the mountains of North Carolina, spent time in Virginia, Tennessee, and South Carolina, and made a few short trips to Kentucky, Indiana, and Alabama. Between meetings and services, we have cherished time with friends and family, including a July 4th celebration, welcoming our close friends' new baby boy, and celebrating my birthday.

God continues to amaze us through the way He uses His people to encourage and care for us! When we started deputation, we worried about Liza missing her cousins and friends while we traveled. While I'm sure she does, the Lord has blessed her with many new friends along the way. One missionary family even scheduled their daughter's birthday party around our travels so Liza could attend! She also made a new friend while we stayed with the Hunt family in Alabama, who graciously hosted us during their church's missions conference. We are thankful for the people God continues to place in our path.

I was able to attend a few services during our home church's Camp Meeting, as well as the Camp Meeting of one of our supporting churches.
